Pastor Randy's Ramblings:

Hello Good People of Bethlehem!

I hope that your holidays went well and that you were able to enjoy family time. I also hope that you were able to experience <u>something</u> that helped draw you closer to God.

I wish to thank you, the members of Bethlehem, for journeying with me as I have pursued ordination. Ordination is a recognition by the association and the conference, that I have received a calling from God for the work that I am doing. In reality, my ordination changes little for you, the people of Bethlehem. Up to this point I have been *licensed* which has allowed me to do all the things which an ordained pastor can do. However, a person can only be licensed for ten years at the same church, so in two years, you may have been seeking another pastor!

For me, ordination is a milestone of personal growth. I have worked through a process for the last two years that has educated me and developed skills I didn't even know I had. For example, two years ago I never would have guessed that I would enjoy hospital chaplaincy. However, at this point in my life, I consider chaplaincy a very important component of my ministry. 
