
LOOKING FOR LITURGISTS!

From the Church Historian:

On May 8, 2005, Bethlehem UCC of rural Kiel celebrated a Service of Groundbreaking to build a new church.

A Committee for Building Accessibility and a Building Fund had been established as early as 1999. The decision to build a new church took years of plans, debates, and votes.

The new building would address the issues of a Pastor's Office, Secretarial Office, Five Sunday School Rooms, a Youth Room, Handicap Accessible Restrooms, Handicap Accessible Building, Large Kitchen, Large Fellowship Hall, Choir Room, Library, Sound Room and Storage.





It was soon realized that bake sales, brat frys, and chili suppers would not be sufficient to fund a 1.2 million dollar building project. A professional fund raising firm was hired which helped develop a capital campaign "Stepping Forward in Faith". This fund raising brought the realization that it would be the commitment and dedication of the members of Bethlehem UCC which would support the project. Members were asked to make pledges for the next 5 years.

Many items were brought from the old church to the new church. These included: pews, stained glass windows, the organ, the steeple andthe people.

The first service in the new building was the December 19, 2005 wedding of Helen Riesterer & Everett Henning.

The first worship service in the new building was January 8, 2006.

As we celebrate 20 years in the "New" church building, we remember the dedication of family and friends of Bethlehem UCC which allowed the loan to be paid off by 2018. While the building will always require updates and maintenance, Bethlehem can focus on its mission to be a caring community of Christians living our faith through worship, fellowship, study and service to others.




